quilt assembly diagram:




Floating Colors 15 bright rectangles in log cabin style

finished quilt size: 57 1/2" x 66" or 146 x 168 cm



finished block size : 9" x 14 1/2" 15 rectangle blocks





materials:

solid white: 2 1/2" yards

assorted colors : 2 yards or 15 fat quarters

batting: 60" x 68" backing: 3 1/2 yards

binding: 1/2 yard cut 7 strips 2 1/2" wide

cutting instructions:

cut 9 strips 2" and subcut into: solid white

30 ~ 2" x 8" strip 4, 5 in block diagram

30 ~ 2" x 5 1/2" strip 6, 7

from each color

30 ~ 2 1/2" x 11" strip 8, 9 in block diagram

30 ~ 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip 10, 11

from 3 favorite colors for the central piece

15 ~ 2 1/2" x 3" strip 1 in block diagram

15 ~ 2 1/2" x 3" strip 2

15 ~ 2 1/2" x 3" strip 3

solid white for sashing

note: cut parallel to selvage = lengthwise grain, cut fabric 61"

cut 10 strips 4" wide parallel to the selvage and subcut into: 4" x 58" strip D in quilt assembly diagram


4" x 59 1/2" strip C

2 ~

4" x 51" strip B

10 ~ 4" x 9 1/2" strip A

making the blocks:



Sew strips 1, 2, 3 together on the 2 1/2" side.

Press the seams open after each step.

Add 4, 5 to the top and bottom, add 6, 7 to right and left.

Add 8, 9 to the top and bottom, add 10, 11 to right and left.

Your unfinished block is now: 9 1/2" x 15".

Trim each block to correct size.

making the quilt top:

Layout the 15 rectangle blocks as shown in the guilt assembly diagram.

Add sashing strips in order: A, B, C, D.

Press the seams open after each step.

Make a guilt sandwich, guilt as desired and bind.
