## quilt layout:



# Happy Birthday a only squares quilt

finished quilt size: 40" x 50" or 101 x 127 cm



finished square size : 2" x 2" 20 squares x 25 rows

Make a quilt sandwich, quilt as desired and bind.



500 squares

#### materials:

print fabrics: minimum 15 different prints; 1/4 yd each

or use your scraps

minimum 5 different colors; 1/4 yd each solids:

batting: 42" x 52" backing: 1 1/2 yards

1/2 yard; cut 5 strips 2 1/2" wide for straight binding:

grain binding

#### cutting instructions:

cut from each fabric 2 strips 2 1/2" wide subcut each strip into 25 squares size 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" all together 500 squares

#### making the blocks:

From each fabric take two squares and layout as desired in 2 rows with 10 squares each for the left and right side of the quilt. Sew together and press in the directions as shown on the diagram:




When sewing the rows together you can match the seams easily as they are interlocking.



Make a total of 24 blocks and finish with 2 single rows of 10 squares.

### making the quilt top:

Sew the blocks together as shown on the diagram. Continue pressing the seams in the same direction as done with the blocks. The last seam is the long one joining the left and right side of the quilt top.



Sew together this seam as last.
